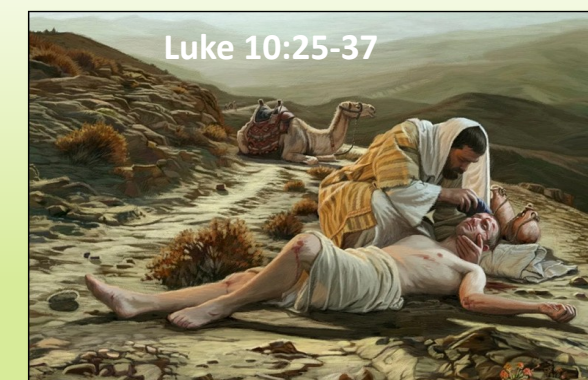

THE CO-ORDINATOR:

- works with our partner organizations
- organizes and co-ordinates sorting of donations, putting together packages for families and arranging pick ups of the packages
- maintains inventory of supplies for donating
- organizes and co-ordinates shopping for supplies
- co-ordinates fundraising, as needed
- co-ordinates volunteers

The co-ordinator commits to approximately 2-8 hours of work per week and is guided by the needs of the program and their own schedule.
