

1) So many grateful comments received from recipients of packages of household items for families!

-Two weeks ago we outfitted a family of 7 as they reunited after some troubles. They were so happy to receive household goods and some food to tide them over for a few days. It really does make a difference to have some basic items.

- We also helped two brothers who recently arrived from the Ukraine. They have jobs but arrived with only two suitcases each with their personal items. A generous landlord was able to help them settle in their own apartment and we were able to give them some household items to help them get started in their new life in Canada. They also received a few days of food to help them out until they receive their first paychecks. Serhii and Nazareth were shocked and overjoyed to receive their package. "So many useful items and an unexpected gift. So many good people!"

Each family received pillows and bedding, towels and hygiene supplies, cleaning supplies, dishes, pots and pans, storage containers, toys and books and kettles and toasters, garbage cans and bags, cooking utensils and kitchen linens. Your donations really do make a huge difference in people's lives!
