


ROUGHRIDER FOOTBALL POOL TICKETS

ST ANNE PARISH BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS HELP



REQUEST...

We have had two people come forward to help with buildings and grounds tasks – one to wash the exterior windows and doors twice annually, and another to help with minor carpentry repairs. We are asking you, our parishioners, to consider taking on a task or two to ensure the church facility is maintained.

The most important request currently is to have someone, or a team, take on lawn and/or grounds care for the summer. This is separate from the Green Thumb ministry.

Some of the minor items which require attention include the following:

- Changing the furnace filters every two months
- Setting up and taking down tables and chairs for church events (funerals, coffee Sundays, etc)
- Arranging for and logging furnace, air conditioner and water heater servicing
- Installing and removing air conditioner covers seasonally
- Arranging for fire extinguisher servicing

Perhaps you might be interested in taking on (coordinating or doing) small projects such as:

- Touch-up painting as required
- Relaying the paving stone sidewalk at the parking lot entrance
- Painting some or all of the church hall (the tan part) or the church confessionals
- Repairing church hall parquet flooring
- Repairing church hall stage storage doors
- Tree stump removal
- Repairing church hall tables
- Sourcing and installing exterior doors weatherstripping
- Repairing a couple of door frames and baseboards

Also, the request is still open for a third co-leader to help coordinate buildings and grounds items. - Thank you for your consideration. -
