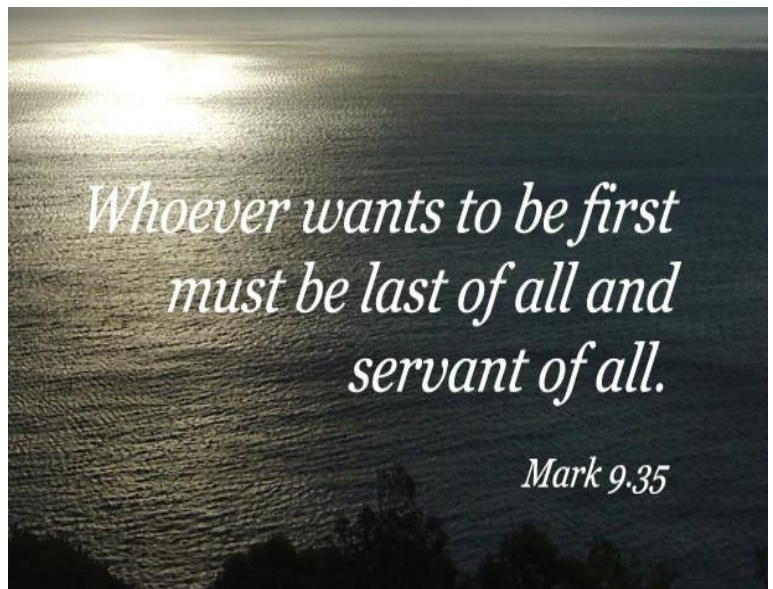
Mass Intention
