Financial Administration

The following is a brief description of the roles/responsibilities related to the positions that require leadership.

PASTORAL COUNCIL CHAIRPERSON

- Works in close collaboration with the parish administrator/pastor to provide leadership and organizes the Parish Pastoral Council in conformance with the Archdiocese of Regina Guidelines.
- Works in close collaboration with the finance council teams, office staff, parish committees, volunteers, and parish partners as required.

PASTORAL COUNCIL VICE-CHAIRPERSON

- In co-leadership with the chairperson, supports leadership of pastoral council and/ or in the chairperson's absence works in close collaboration with the pastor, pastoral and finance council teams, office staff, parish committees, volunteers, and parish partners as required.

LITURGY COMMITTEE CHAIRPERSON

- Works in close collaboration with the pastor and pastoral assistant, responsible to provide meaningful liturgical celebrations.
- Oversees liturgical subcommittees such as Environment, Music Ministry, Altar Servers, Children's Liturgy, Lectors, Extra-Ordinary Ministers, Gift Bearers, Greeters and Sacristans.

BUILDING AND GROUNDS

- Committee reports to the Finance Council Chairperson.
- Committee is responsible for maintenance and repair of the parish buildings and grounds.
- Seeking volunteers who can provide advice and guidance and/or hands on skills such as gardening, minor repairs...

FINANCIAL ADMINISTRATION

- Works with Parish Coordinator to assist and guide financial accounting.
- Opportunities for multiple volunteers to support this role.
